Wounded in Action



Private First Class Michael Ferrari, a veteran of campaigns in North Africa and other major engagements has been wounded in action according to a telegram received last evening by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Nicholas Ferrari, 129 Crest Avenue. The telegram from the War Department read in part, "Regret to inform you your son, Private First Class Michael Ferrari, was wounded in action in France, June 17."

Michael has two other brothers in the service whom he met in England this past February. They are Pfc. John Ferrari and Technician S-c Stephen Ferrari, both of the U. S. Medical Corps, stationed somewhere in England.
