Gold Leaves For C. of C. Secretary

Promotion of Harry K. Trend, of Bethlehem, to the rank of major in the Marine Corps has been announced. Major Trend, Chamber of Commerce secretary-on-leave, is currently on duty in the Pacific theatre as liaison officer on the staff of Brigadier General L. H. M. Sanderson, commanding general of the Fourth Marine Air Wing.

Previous to that he was on the staff of Major General L. E. Woods and has seen duty in the combat zone.

Major Trend entered the Marine Corps Reserves more than three years ago, and after tours of duty at Quantico, Va., and Mojave, Calif., he went overseas a year ago as operations officer for a Marine Air Group, which together with Army and Seabee units, established one of the foremost island outposts from which the campaigns for the Philippines and Okinawa were launched.
