F. Makos, seaman 1/C, and other crewmen of the destroyer-minelayer, USS Henry A. Wiley, had a hand in transforming the ship from a "half-breed" into a "thoroughbred", ready for any role she may be assigned in the peacetime navy.

At Iwo Jima, Makos' ship was engaged in bombardment, illumination and screening duties. At Okinawa, where she arrived for duty eight days before the invasion forces, the Wiley remained for the whole show.
