**Paul E. Cope Assigned  
To Serve On Navy LSM**

Paul E. Cope, third member of the Cope family now in the armed forces, has been chosen by the Navy to serve aboard an LSM (Landing Ship Medium), the speed carrier of the attack that has been especially developed for Pacific duty.

Now stationed at the Amphibious Training Base in Little Creek, Va., Cope is going through a rigorous training program to prepare for duty as radioman on the swift new invasion vessel.

He was employed by the Bethlehem Steel Company before joining the Navy in April, 1944. The other Copes now serving with the U. S. fighting forces are: Army Sergeant Woodrow and Ensign Roy W. The three men are sons of Mrs. E. E. Cope, who resides at 1217 Broadway.
