Sent to Middletown**

S/Sgt. Stanley Kobylarz, son of Mr. and Mrs. A. J. Kobylarz, Heights Rural Station, Easton, and a crew member on a B-24, has been assigned to the Middletown Air Technical Service Command.

Sgt. Kobylarz entered the service in March, 1943, as a private. He attended Radio and Gunnery schools in this country, and was sent overseas to the European Theater of Operations as a radio operator and gunner on a B-24. His plane was shot down over Vienna, Austria and he was taken prisoner for 11 months. He wears the European Theater of Operations Ribbon with three stars, the Air Medal and the Good Conduct Medal. He returned to the United States in June, 1945.
