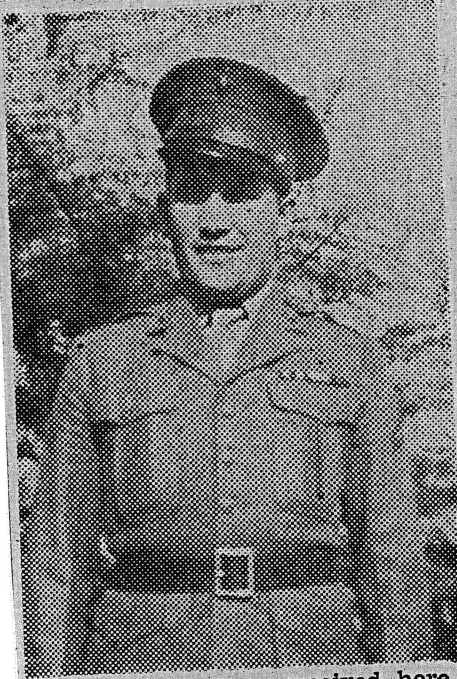


Rice, James J.

Saipan Casualty

Word has been received here of the death of Corporal James J. Rice, U. S. Marine Corps, who was killed in action June 14 at Saipan. Cpl. Rice was born in Bethlehem, May 10, 1912, and attended elementary schools here, finishing his education at Washington High, New York City. He enlisted in the Marines when he was 18, received his training at North Carolina and completed his enlistment term at Nicaragua, in April, 1930. After Pearl Harbor he re-enlisted, went to New River, Calif., and was sent to the Marshall Islands.

Besides his mother, Mrs. Mary Caldwell Rice, formerly of this city, he is survived by a wife and daughter, Rose Marie Rice, and two sisters, Mrs. Thomas F. Clarke and Mrs. H. W. Zieler, all of New York City.
