Major Harry Harchar, former associate editor of the American Army newspaper, Stars and Stripes, has been promoted to the rank of Lieutenant Colonel, according to word received from Washington by his father, Andrew J. Harchar, 316 West Fourth St.

Lt. Col. Harchar, a graduate of Liberty High and Lehigh University where he captained the swimming team and was a member of the Brown and White staff. He was with the first convoy of U. S. soldiers to land in Ireland and with the largest convoy of troops to land in Africa in 1943.

Harchar was one of the main instigators in organizing the unique reunion in London of Lehigh, Lafayette and Rutgers alumni stationed in Great Britain in September of 1943.

Lt. Col. Harchar's wife, the former Miss Helen Clymer, resides with her parents at 519 Sixth Ave.
