First Draft Group Under New Ruling

County Board No. 1 at Bangor Revamps Draft Lists Under New Directive

In sweeping changes that have affected many Slate Belter who recently felt that it would not be long before they would be donning Army khaki or Navy blue, the members of Northampton County Draft Board No. 1 with headquarters on Broadway in Bangor, yesterday afternoon put into effect the new regulations affecting draftees from this vicinity.

Called to a meeting of the board by President Oscar Greenzweig of Wind Gap, members of the board reviewed the directive received Monday from State Selective Service Headquarters in Harrisburg and rescinded the call for many fathers and men who have passed the age and employment standards recently defined by National authority.

Late yesterday afternoon, John Hall, chief clerk of the local board issued new lists containing the names of men who will leave for service with both the Army and the Navy this week and recalled all previous lists. However, no definite word as to how long this new directive would be in affect were forthcoming late last evening.
