**Pvt. Theo. Haase,  
Quakertown Man,  
Missing in Action**

A War Department telegram was received Saturday by Mrs. Theodore G. Haase, the former Mary Cicon, at her home, Quakertown, R. D. 3, to the effect that her husband, Private Theodore G. Haase, 32, son of Mr. and Mrs. William Haase, of Lynbrook, L. I., has been reported missing in action in Luxembourg since Dec. 22.

Inducted into service Dec. 19, 1942, he was sent overseas last April, subsequently seeing spearhead D-Day action in France, Germany and Belgium.

Private Haase received training at Camp McCoy, Wisc., Camp Breckenridge, Ken., and maneuvers in Nashville, Tenn., after which he was sent to England, where he served with the Engineer Corps. Prior to his induction he was employed by Bethlehem Steel. Private Haase is a member of St. Isidore's Catholic Church, Quakertown.
