**PEN ARGYL YOUNG MAN  
DISCHARGED FROM ARMY**

Lewis Parker, son of Mr. and Mrs. Carmen Parker, of George st., Pen Argyl, is reported to be enroute to his home, having been given a discharge from the U. S. Army, after having been in service at Camp Cook, Calif. He is expected to arrive here over the weekend.

Parker was inducted into the U. S. Army at Wilkes-Barre Induction Center on March 26, 1942. After being transferred to Camp Cook, Calif., he sustained an injury to a knee. While in the Camp hospital, Parker suffered a serious attack of pneumonia, which prevented an operation upon the leg. His knee still is crippled. He is married to the former Miss Joyce Hendershot of Pen Argyl.
