**George P. Weaver, FC3/C,  
Home on Leave  
After Two Years**

George P. Weaver, fire controlman, third class, son of Mrs. Theresa H. Weaver, 44 East Garrison Street, is home on a 14-day leave after serving two years in the South Pacific with the Navy.

FC3/C Weaver enlisted in Philadelphia, March 20, 1943, at the age of 17 years. He received "boot" training at Sampson, N. Y. Prior to enlisting he attended Bethlehem Technical High School.

While overseas the young Navy man served aboard the USS Waterman (DE 740). He holds the American Area Campaign ribbon, Philippine Liberation ribbon with Operations Star and Asiatic-Pacific Area Campaign ribbon with Operations Stars for the following: Marianas, Western Carolinas, Leyte, Luzon, Iwo Jima, Okinawa, Gunto and assaults on the Japanese empire, including the initial occupation.
