Awarded posthumously, Mrs. Margaret (Lancsak) Wernett, widow of Staff Sergeant Charles Wernett, U. S. Air Corps, killed in action on April 25, 1944, "somewhere in Italy," is in receipt of the Purple Heart, Air Medal with Oak Leaf Cluster, and a presidential citation, sent to her through governmental channels. The Air Medal and Oak Leaf Cluster was awarded "for meritorious achievement in aerial flight while participating in sustained operational activities against the enemy." A son of Mr. and Mrs. Clinton Wernett of 1423 Monocacy Street, he enlisted in the armed forces on April 8, 1941. He was a former employe of the Bethlehem Steel Company.
