Bristol Brothers Promoted



Three sons of Mr. and Mrs. Albert Bristol, 2049 Kenmore Avenue, former Ashley residents, have recently been promoted while serving overseas.

Walter Bristol, now Fireman 1/c, entered the Navy in May, 1942 and completed his training at Sampson, N. Y. In July of that year, he was sent overseas and has been serving in the Pacific ever since. In a recent letter to his parents, he writes of meeting his brother, Albert, "somewhere in the Pacific". He stated their meeting was so wonderful and unexpected and that they spent four hours together reminiscing about the home town.

Sgt. James Bristol was promoted while serving

with the First Army in Germany. He entered the service in April, 1940 and trained with a cavalry regiment before it was converted into an armored division. His wife, the former Miss Thurlo Lee, resides in Louisville, Ky., with their son, James Donald.

Another Navy man, Albert Bristol, was advanced to Seaman 1-c while serving as a gunner aboard an L.S.T. "somewhere in the Pacific". S 1/c Bristol has taken part in numerous invasions. He entered the service in February, 1943 and completed his training at the Great Lakes Naval Training Center, Ill.
