LOCAL DRAFT BOARDS SIGN UP 62 IN CITY

Figures on Registration of 18-Year-Olds Friday and Saturday Released.

Registration of eighteen-year-old Bethlehem youths on Friday and Saturday of last week, has increased Uncle Sam's eligibles for combat duty by 62, according to figures available today at the headquarters of the city's three draft boards.

In the two days 37 were registered at the headquarters of Local Draft Board No. 1; 21, by Draft Board No. 2, and 4 by Draft Board No. 3.

Thursday, December 17, is the deadline for the registering of youths who were born between July 1 and August 31, 1924.

Those in charge of the registration would not venture a guess as to the approximate number of young men in this age bracket who, under the selective service law, are required to register. From one source it was learned that many of the young men of this city, eighteen years of age and younger, have already enlisted in the country's service.
