Soldier Killed In Crash to be Buried Monday

Corporal Technician Frank J. Cenyuga, son of Matthew and Anelie Cenyuga, of Middletown, severely injured in a bus-truck accident on New Year morning, succumbed to his injuries on Monday at a U. S. Army hospital at Camp Crowder, Mo. He suffered internal injuries and a compound fracture of his left leg.

Born in Bethlehem, the young soldier was inducted into the combat services on Feb. 6, 1942. He was a graduate of Bethlehem Technical High School, drafting department and a member of the Sacred Heart parish, Middletown.

Besides his parents, he is survived by two sisters, Mary, at home, and Mrs. George Minchek, of Prospect Heights.

The funeral will be held on Monday at 9 a. m. Requiem mass will be celebrated at 9:30 a. m., in the Sacred Heart Church, followed by burial in the family plot in Holy Saviour Cemetery.
