AN AIR SERVICE COMMAND DEPOT, ENGLAND — Technical Sergeant Daniel M. Kottek, son of Mrs. Lena Kottek, of 90 E. Broad St., Bethlehem, Pa., and former employe of the Bethlehem Steel Corp., is now a supply specialist at an Air Service Command depot in England which repaired more than 4,000 fighter engines and 7,000 combat aircraft in 1944, according to figures just released by ASC headquarters. Sergeant Kottek assisted in procuring the tools, machinery and equipment which speeded the depot's large-scale production.
