Mr. and Mrs. Charles Talaber, 1416 East Fifth Street, received a telegram from the War Department, stating that their son, Pfc. Raymond Talaber, U. S. M. C., was slightly wounded in action Easter Sunday on Okinawa.

Raymond's two brothers are also serving, John, in the Palau Islands, and Joseph, recently shipped to California. William, a Merchant Marine who was wounded in England, has since been discharged.
