Home On Furlough After Long Service On Battle Front

Pfc. William McKinnon, of the United States Marine Corps is home on a 21-day furlough after spending the past 15 months in the Pacific theater of war. He arrived on Friday morning at the home of his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Walter McKinnon, 923 Cayuga Stret. His marriage to Miss Dorothy Minnich of Allentown will take place Thursday evening.

A brother, Pvt. Ralph McKinnon also of the Marines, arrived home this morning for a five-day furlough that he might visit his brother. Pvt. Ralph McKinnon has been stationed at Columbia, N. C.

A third son of the McKinnons, Pfc. Walter McKinnon, also a member of the Marine Corps, is stationed at San Diego, Cal., and though unable to get a furlough at this time expects to meet his brother when he returns to his base at Long Beach, Cal.
