Corporal Adolph L. Solderitch and his brother, Pfc. Joseph Solderitch, 67 West Union Street, are members of the 168th "Rainbow" Regiment's Cannon Company, which recently fired its 150,000th combat round across the Fifth Army front in Italy.

The company, composed of two batteries each armed with three 75 millimeter guns, was organized in Tunisia following the battle at Faid Pass in March, 1943, and has since been in combat more than 400 days.

Cpl. Adolph has been a gunner since May, 1943. Another brother, Pfc. Edward Solderitch, is with a Military Police unit in France.
