# **Wife Hears Local Soldier Is Now German Prisoner**

Technician Fifth Grade Joseph M. Foley, one of Uncle Sam's paratroopers, reported missing since D-Day, is a prisoner of the Germans.

This information was received today in a War Department telegram, sent through channels of the International Red Cross, to the wife of the soldier, the former Miss Joan Mangan, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. John Mangan of 532 Thirteenth Avenue. Mrs. Foley and her mother are presently visiting at Pittsburgh.

A graduate of Bethlehem Catholic High School and a former employe of the Bethlehem Steel Company, he participated in three major missions, making parachute jumps in Sicily, Italy and France.

August 18, 1944
