A 7TH AAF BASE IN THE MARIANAS—Second Lt. Robert B. Miller, Bethlehem, Pa., has been awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross and second Oak Leaf Cluster to the Air Medal for extraordinary achievement in flight, while participating in aerial operations against the Japs in the Central Pacific. Piloting a fighter plane, he teamed up with two other pilots to knock down a Japanese fighter plane over Saipan. Presentation is being made by Major General Robert W. Douglass, Jr., commanding general of the 7th Air Force. Lt. Miller, veteran of the 7th AAF Marianas campaign, is the son of George F. Miller, 1325 Montrose Ave., Bethlehem. He is a graduate of Liberty High School and Lehigh University in Bethlehem.
