Posthumous Honors For Allentown Marine 1943

Posthumous honors for the late Pvt. Paul R. Heller Jr., son of Mr. and Mrs. Paul R. Heller of 210 North Hall Street, Allentown, were received yesterday by the parents when the medal of the Purple Heart and a Presidential citation arrived by mail from the U. S. Navy Department.

The award of the Purple Heart, established Aug. 7, 1782, for soldiers of the Revolution and continued ever since by this country, was made "for military merit and for wounds recived in action," resulting in his death on Guadalcanal Oct. 8, 1942.
