Mrs. Caroline Shambora received a War Department telegram last week informing her that her husband, Pfc. Peter Shambora, had been slightly wounded in action on Leyte, November 8, 1944, and has been awarded the Purple Heart.

Pfc. Shambora, who has never been on a furlough since entering the service October 10, 1942, is hospitalized in the Philippines at the present time. Prior to his induction, he was employed by the Bethlehem Steel Company. A brother, John Shambora, is a prisoner of war of Japan at present. Pfc. Shambora's wife, the former Caroline Grube, resides at 330 Franklin Street.
