Mr. and Mrs. Frank Hunsberger, 69 West Fourth Street, Northampton, in a message from the War Department, December 11, were informed that their son, Sgt. Raymond C. Hunsberger is missing in action in Germany. Prior to this announcement, Sgt. Hunsberger was seriously wounded in France June 26. He was hospitalized four months in England and was awarded the Purple Heart.

He was sent back into action and was reported missing. The young soldier served with the Infantry for 8 months.

He received his training at Camp Wheeler, Fort Dix, N. J. Camp Gordon, Ga. Sgt. Hunsberger is a former employee of the Pennsylvania Dress Company.
