Philip Lynett Made Captain In Air Forces

Captain Lynett who has been in the Aleutians for the past two years, is a former Bethlehemite, a graduate of Catholic High School and a grandson of Philip C. Reilly, of 717 Mount Erie Avenue, Bethlehem.

A son and another grandson of Mr. Reilly have received promotions recently according to information received here. The son, Francis J. Reilly, who is at the quartermaster corps at Camp Lee has just been made a first sergeant and the other grandson, Francis Goldcamp, son of Mr. and Mrs. C. F. Goldcamp, of Pittsburgh, has been made a first lieutenant, bomber pilot.

After completing his missions in the European theater of operations he returned to Pittsburgh for a furlough with his parents after which he will go to Texas for further assignment. Lieut. Goldcamp is the holder of the Distinguished Flying Cross and Air Medal with four Oak Leaf Clusters.
