Home On Leave JAN 4 1944

Having completed their eight weeks of basic training with the U. S. Marines at Parris Island, S. C., Pfc. Edwin Donnenberger and Pfc. Arthur Donnenberger are now on ten-day furlough visiting their sister, Miss Margaret Dannenberger, 528 Seventh Avenue.

They are the twin sons of Rev. and Mrs. Adolph Otto Dannenberger, Moravian missionaries to Nicaragua for the past 35 years, and upon their return to Parris Island Monday, Jan. 10, they expect to be transferred.

Prior to enlisting in the Marines, Edwin was employed at the Bethlehem office of the Call-Chronicle newspapers and Arthur served as manager of a Bethlehem restaurant. The twin brothers will observe their 21st birthday anniversary March 28.
