**Cpl. Trinkle Cuts
Hair On Iwo Jima
As Battle Rages**

IWO JIMA (Delayed)—Less than a half-mile behind the front lines, Cpl. Julius S. Trinkle, of 362 East Twelfth Street, Northampton, Pa., set up a barber chair a week after Marines landed on Iwo Jima and did a rushing business, reports Sgt. Dick Dashiell, a Marine Corps correspondent.

A Third Marine Division veteran, Trinkle cut hair during the Bougainville and Guam operations as well.

"Haven't nicked an ear yet," he said as shells whooshed overhead.
