### **Air Forces Technician Made Special Mission**

Corporal Ben Wiener, former Northampton High School basketball team captain, and member of the Allentown Jewish Community Center, has returned from a four months special mission through Southwest Pacific islands. A radio technician in the Army Air Forces he made a stop at Sydney, Australia, for a short time and dropped in at a Red Cross service club where he noticed on the day's registry the name of Lieutenant Monroe Adler, Allentown, but being unable to stay he had no chance to meet Lieutenant Adler, also a member of the Community Center.

Corporal Wiener, 28, is the son of Mrs. Anna Wiener, of Cementon. He has two brothers in service, Tony at Camp Butler, N. C., and Alex, somewhere in England. Another brother, Sam, whose wife is a sergeant in the WACS, has had a physical examination for possible service in the Merchant Marine and has been called for induction into the armed forces on October 19.

Corporal Wiener has been in service for 22 months, leaving the management of a dining establishment in Palmerton. He served at Jefferson Barracks, Mo., and then at Patterson Field, Dayton, Ohio. He has returned to Ohio after visiting his mother and friends in Allentown.
