HQS, PACIFIC AIR COMMAND, Manila — The Bronze Star Medal for exceptionally meritorious service has been awarded to First Lieut. Lynn C. Bartlett, son of Mr. and Mrs. F. C. Bartlett, of 222 Warren Square, Administrative Officer at General George C. Kenney's Pacific Air Command Headquarters here. The presentation was made by Lieut. Gen. Ennis C. Whitehead, deputy commander, at an impressive ceremony held recently.

Veteran of 29 months foreign duty, 24-year-old Lieutenant Bartlett entered the service as an enlisted man in February, 1943, and received his commission in January, 1945. In addition to the Bronze Star Medal, he wears the Asiatic-Pacific Theater Ribbon with three battle stars.
