

Jones, Carolyn H.

Carolyn H. Jones,
WAC Captain,
Concludes Service

PHOENIXVILLE, Pa., Jan. 11—
Captain Carolyn H. Jones, WAC,
daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Harry
Jones, 428 High St., Bethlehem, di-
rector of the Blind Hobby Shop at
Valley Forge General Hospital, was
separated from the Woman's Army
Corps today after three years serv-
ice, it was announced by Brigadier
General W. W. Vaughan, hospital
commanding general. She will be-
come manager of the Blind Work
Shop and Home Industries for the
State of Florida with headquarters
at Tampa.

Captain Jones who took her degree
in Occupational Therapy at the
School of Design in Boston, Mass.,
taught manual training and occupa-
tional therapy in New York state be-
fore enlisting in the Women's Army
Corps. She visited the homes of the
blind for the New York State Com-
mission for the Blind from which
she had been on military leave since
January 5, 1943.

She received her commission at
Officers' Candidate School the fol-
lowing May and was assigned as
Special Service Officer at Fitzsim-
mons General Hospital in Denver,
Colo., and later at the Ruston, La.,
Station Hospital.

Upon assignment to Valley Forge
General Hospital, Captain Jones as-
sumed charge of the blind occupa-
tional therapy program and organ-
ized the Hobby Shop here.
