On Hospital Ship ~~Aug~~ **23 1944**

Cpl. John E. Hudak, 52 East Union Street, is serving on the hospital ship "Blanche F. Sigman", named after a U. S. Army nurse who was killed by a German bomb while working in a tent on the Anzio beachhead. The ship carries the Normandy wounded from the English coast to hospitals near friends and families back in the States, and supplies the boys with most modern medical and surgical equipment available to speed their convalescence and recovery.
