### Leaves For Georgia To Join Brother

Mrs. Samuel Keim of 731 Seventh Avenue, left last evening for Fort Benning, Ga., to meet her brother, M/Sgt. Kenenth S. Bauer, who was officially retired from the U. S. Army after serving for twenty-eight years.

Sgt. Bauer enlisted May 7, 1917 during the first World War and served on guard duty during the West Virginia strike. During his early enlistment, he also helped guard the Fort Sam Houston Arsenal, San Antonio, Tex. For the past 22 years he was stationed at Fort Benning, Ga., and was manager of the main theater.
