Sends Thanks For Gift**

John Griffith, president of the Bethlehem Tobacco Club, is in receipt of a letter from Corporal William J. Bayzak, a patient at Valley Forge Hospital, thanking the organization for the Christmas present received from JAN 6 1944

Corporal Bayzak, a native of Pittsburgh, fought side by side with Bethlehem soldiers during engagements in Africa, and is recuperating from injuries received.

He told Mr. Griffith that when he leaves the hospital he plans to visit Bethlehem and personally thank the club. The gift of the club to the wounded "vets" included candy, cigarettes, chewing gum, razor blades and shaving cream.
