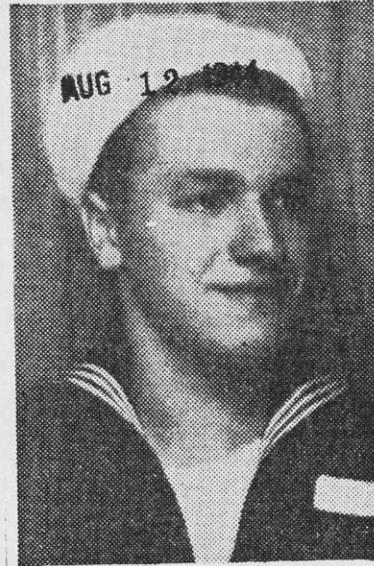

Navy Now Lists Andrew Billets Officially Dead

Andrew Edward Billets, 19, son of Mrs. Mary Sniscak Billets, 538 Atlantic Street, has been officially listed as dead by the U. S. Navy Department.

Word was received by his mother today that the young sailor was aboard a warship which was torpedoed and since he has been listed as missing more than a year, he must now be presumed dead.

He entered the service two years ago. Besides his mother, he is survived by two brothers in the armed forces, both overseas. They are John, stationed in New Guinea, and Michael, with the invasion forces in France.

Memorial services will be held for the young sailor next Saturday at 8 a. m. in SS. Cyril and Methodius Church.
