Capt. James E. Ray, son of Mr. and Mrs. James R. Ray, 1103 Raymond Ave., was separated from the Army today, after serving four years with the Ordnance Department, two of which were served overseas in the European Theater.

Capt. Ray enlisted with the rank of private following his graduation from Franklin & Marshall Military Institute, June 4, 1942. He received his commission at Aberdeen, Md., April 17, 1943, prior to receiving his overseas assignment. The young officer is a graduate of Bethlehem High School.
