## Rev. Enloe Commissioned As Chaplain

The Rev. Roger Enloe, minister of the First Presbyterian Church, North Side, received his final examination at Philadelphia yesterday, was commissioned a lieutenant, junior grade, in the Chaplains' Corps of the United States Naval Reserve and was sworn in. He will report at the Naval Training School for Chaplains at the College of William and Mary, Williamsburg, Va., for an eight weeks indoctrination course. At the conclusion of this he will be assigned to duty.

At a meeting of the congregation of the North Side Church this week, the Rev. Mr. Enloe was granted an indefinite leave of absence and the

Presbytery of Lehigh at a meeting Wednesday concurred with this action at the request of the representative of the congregation, Warren Driver.

The Rev. Mr. Enloe is a graduate of Davidson College, Davidson, N. C., and the Theological Seminary, Princeton, New Jersey. He was ordained at the Druid Hills Presbyterian Church, Atlanta, Ga., June 22, 1941, and became assistant pastor of the North Side Church the same year. On Oct. 23, 1942, he was installed as pastor of the local congregation.
