After more than a year of overseas service, S/Sgt. Donald L. Collitt, 1621 Elm Street, is homeward bound with the 1376th Engineer Petroleum Distribution Company, which supplied tanks and planes of the American armies in Europe with 2,000,000 gallons of gasoline daily.

The 1376th arrived overseas in July, 1944, and shortly afterwards went to France for pipeline construction along the famous supply route, the Red Ball Highway. The company is at Camp Atlanta, near Chalons, France, awaiting redeployment to the United States.
