2nd Lt. Eugene C. LeVan, son of Mrs. Nancy LeVan, South Broad St., Nazareth, was commissioned and awarded silver navigation wings on Jan. 5th at Selman Field, Monroe, La. He was graduated with the first class of 1944 at Selman Field, a station in the Army Air Forces Training Command.

2nd Lt. LeVan is spending a furlough with his mother, Mrs. Nancy LeVan, and his wife, the former Miss June Kellow, daughter of Mrs. Ethel Horting, Nazareth. It was revealed that the young couple were married last June while Miss Kellow paid a visit to Southern camp where he was stationed. She is training to become a nurse at a hospital in Philadelphia.

2nd Lt. LeVan enlisted on Feb. 8, 1943, and received pre-flight train-

ing at Maxwell Field, Ala., then studied aerial gunnery at Ft. Myers, Fla., from which place he was transferred to Selman Field, Monroe, La., for advanced navigation, and was graduated.

He is a graduate of Nazareth High School and played football with the Nazareth Park team. Upon the completion of his present furlough he will receive further combat training at a camp in Tennessee.
