Unarmed Bath Ack-Ack Soldier Captures German Officer and Private In Italy

WITH THE FIFTH ARMY, Italy. —Unarmed and several miles behind the front line, Private First Class Herman Jany, of Bath, Pa., and several anti-aircraft buddies captured a German officer and private during the Fifth Army's offensive up the Italian coast.

Jany's group was making a reconnaissance along a narrow trail when it was surprised by two Ger-

mans coming around a bend. The Jerries were armed with pistols while Jany and his buddies had left their rifles in a truck about ten yards behind.

To the ack ack men's amazement the Germans, a first lieutenant and a private, came forward and gave themselves up.
