## Sgt. Tachovsky Missing After German Flight

Staff Sergeant Harry F. Tachovsky, Jr., 21, son of Mr. and Mrs. Harry Tachovsky, 1 Finady Avenue, was reported last night by the War Department as missing in action following a flight over Germany.

Sgt. Tachovsky, a waist-gunner on a bomber with the U. S. Eighth Air Forces, has been listed as missing since Sept. 27, according to the telegram received from the War Department.

The youth entered the Air Corps upon graduating from Liberty High School, being sent to Keesler Field, Miss., upon enlisting. He received his wings at Keesler Field and further training at Westover, Mass. He entered the service in February, 1943, and was sent overseas about four months ago.

In the four months he was in action he won the Air Medal and four Oak Leaf Clusters which were sent home to his parents. The last letter received by his parents was written Sept. 25.
