Chief Bailey has seen service at Casablanca, the invasion of Normandy, and during the invasion of Leyte and Oromoc Bay. He has served on a destroyer, destroyer-escort and attack transport. He wears ribbons for the American Area, European-African-Middle Eastern Area with one star, the Asiatic-Pacific Area with two stars, the Good Conduct Medal with one star, and the American Defense Medal. He also holds the Purple Heart.

Another Navy man who recently arrived at the Norfolk training base is Joseph Bozilesky, 17-year-old seaman 2/C, USNR, from Freemansburg. His parents, Mr. and Mrs. Harry Bozilesky, reside at 50 Clearfield Street. His brother, John, 27, was killed in action in Germany.
