### **Stanley Werkheiser, Nazareth Soldier, Missing in Action**

Mrs. Stanley R. Werkheiser, 203 East Center Street, Nazareth, was informed by a War Department telegram that her husband, Pfc. Stanley R. Werkheiser, is missing in action somewhere in Germany since Feb. 21.

Pfc. Werkheiser entered the Army on Jan. 11, 1944, and was stationed at Camp Croft, S. C., Camp Shelby, Miss., and Camp Meade, Md., before being sent overseas last July.

He had been wounded on Sept. 10 in Metz, France, and had spent several months in hospitals recovering from the shrapnel wound in his arm.

Pfc. Werkheiser is the son of Mrs. Elsie Johnson, Bath, R. 2. He had been employed by the Lone Star Cement Company, Nazareth, before entering the service.

He is the father of two children, Richard, 9, and Beverly, 7.
