Pvt. William C. Bauer Jr., son of Mr. and Mrs. William C. Bauer Sr., 742 Dellwood Street, is reported wounded in action in Germany since October 9, in a War Department telegram received this morning.

A member of the Medical Detachment of the 120 Inf., he was inducted July 7, 1943. Pvt. Bauer received his training at Camp Grant, Ill., and after a short furlough, was sent to Fort Devers, Mass. In England since March, 1944, he saw action in France. He was reported missing in action on August 7, but the report was proven to be erroneous.

Pvt. Bauer also saw action in Belgium and Holland. Educated in Bethlehem schools, he was employed by Bethlehem Steel Company before his induction.
