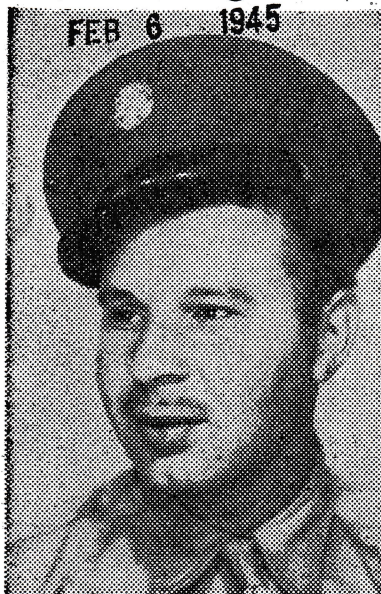


Savo, George

Following the news of his promotion, his brother received a trunk of war souvenirs, containing Nazi helmets and gas masks, Luxembourg beer stein, French powder, perfumes and handkerchiefs; German limburger cheese and German and French coins.

According to Savo, who is fighting on the Third Army Front, people on the home front are hearing too much about the good times and beautiful girls in Paris instead of the misery and sorrow that occur every day in the lives of our fighting Yanks there. He also stated he caught a glimpse of a local boy riding to the front lines on a truck who has since been listed as killed in action.
