**United in London as They Wait
for Train; Francis
Keleher Writes.**

Two cousins in Britain were recently united in a London underground, according to word received today by John D. Keleher, 907 East Fourth Street, this city, from his son Francis, one of the pair.

A letter received Monday by Mr. Keleher, chief Northampton County delinquent tax collector, from his son with the U. S. Army in Ireland said that on September 20, Francis was looking all over the country for his cousin, Jerry Vincent McCarthy, who had previously lived here with the Kelehers.

Keleher today received another letter from Francis, dated September 28, which informed the local resident that during a visit to London, his son, waiting in the underground for a train, met McCarthy who was waiting there for the same train. They know now where each is located.
