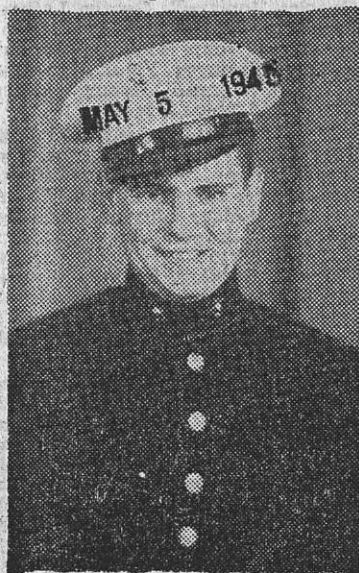


Korostinsky, Louis

Recuperating



Corporal Louis Korostinsky has been wounded in action against the enemy at Okinawa. Official confirmation of this news was received yesterday by his father, Danko Korostinsky of 1621 Eighth Street. Previously a letter sent to John Mihaljow, a step-brother of the young Marine, stated that the wound is a chest wound and that Cpl. Korostinsky is recuperating in a hospital somewhere in the Marianas. A former employe of the Bethlehem Steel Company, the young Corporal was inducted in November of 1942 when he was 18 years of age. He was shipped overseas in March, 1943, and since that time has been stationed in the South Pacific area with no furloughs granted. A sister Mary is a WAC, stationed in Miami, Fla.
