Pfc. M. J. Takach Wounded on French Front

Pfc. Michael J. Takach, son of Mr. and Mrs. Charles Latzo, 1628½ Second St., was wounded in France on July 10, according to word received by his mother from the Adjutant General's office. The extent of his injuries are not known, although the mother has been assured the wounds are not serious.

Private Takach, who has been through the African and Sicilian campaigns, was promoted to the rank of private first class in June. He had been stationed in England for a period before assignment to the Normandy front. He has been awarded the Purple Heart.

He was inducted into service on November 8, 1942 and after infantry training at Camp Campbell, Kentucky, for five months, was sent overseas to the African area. He was employed by the Yellow Cab Co. before entering service.
