**Seaman Back In U. S.
After Overseas Duty**

Joseph M. Orlando, 19, seaman, first class, USNR, is back in the United States after duty in the European theater where he participated in the invasions of France.

Orlando, son of Michael Orlando, 417 Adams Street, served aboard an LST, which landed troops and equipment on the coast of Normandy. Later his ship took part in the invasion of southern France.

During the summer of 1943, Orlando was stationed at the Amphibious Training Command's Little Creek, Va., base, and in the fall of the same year he was assigned to its Fort Pierce, Fla., base.

Orlando attended the Broughal High School in Bethlehem, where he was a member of the football and baseball teams.
