**HELLERTOWN SOLDIER
IS "MISSING IN ACTION"**

**Telegram to Parents of Sergeant
Raymond Weaver Brings News.**

Sergeant Raymond Weaver, son of Mr. and Mrs. Lloyd Weaver, front Street, Hellertown, was reported missing in action somewhere in Africa since October 29 in a telegram sent to his parents by the War Department this morning.

Sergeant Weaver enlisted in the U. S. Army two years ago and, prior to taking part in the battles being waged on the North African front, had received his training at a gunner's school in Nevada and also at MacDill Field, Tampa, Fla., and at Barksdale Field, Louisiana.

After completing his training course he was stationed for some time at West Palm Beach, Fla. Thence he flew to Brazil, South America, where he remained for several days before hopping across the Atlantic to Cairo, Egypt. He was also stationed for some time in Eritrea, on the North African coast.

The War Department communication stated a report will be sent later.
