Aviation Cadet Louis E. Miller, son of Mr. and Mrs. Louis G. Miller, 929 Sixth Avenue, has been commissioned second lieutenant and awarded the silver wings of the aerial bombardier, supplementing previously won aerial gunner insignia.

Lieut. Miller is a graduate of Liberty High School, class of 1942, where as an undergraduate he was a member of the football, basketball and track teams. Later he attended Lehigh University, where he took part in R. O. T. C. activities. His brother is now serving the U. S. Quartermaster Corps with the rank of First Lieutenant.

Prior to his successful completion of 18 weeks of flight and combat training in high level precision bombing and navigation at Kirtland Field, Lieut. Miller was stationed at Las Vegas, Nevada, where he graduated from the Army Air Forces flexible gunnery school as an aerial gunner.
